Our basic method for bass line construction is pretty straightforward. We'll keep our rhythms simple for now: one note per beat. On the downbeat, we're going to play the root; and on the last beat of each bar, we're going to play a chromatic approach tone leading into the next root, or it's corresponding fifth.

How to Write a Walking Bass Line - Learn Jazz Standards

The first lesson will be building walking bass lines in the 4/4 - meter swing style. In general, it is a good strategy to play the root of the chord on the downbeat of the measure. For example: The remaining three beats can be filled in by either repeating the root or playing the 5th of the chord. Also, the root can be displaced by octaves.
