Shifting gears in a Formula One car is not the same as shifting gears in a road car with a manual transmission. Instead of using a traditional "H" gate selector, drivers select gears using paddles located just behind the steering wheel. Downshifting is done on one side of the steering wheel, upshifting on the other.

As someone who insists on manual gears whenever possible, even I tended to drive F1 with automatic gears. I was struggling with the speed with which you need to go through the gears, especially up through the low gears and down under heavy braking.

They use the clutch to get off and for full stops but they use a seamless shift transmission which utilizes paddle shifters the FIA has strict rules that do not allow full automatic set ups for F1...

In essence the transmissions use a clutch driving a manual gearbox of six or seven forward speeds, which transfers drive via a differential, weight reduction is critical with this component, as it is quite a large percentage of the total weight of the car and as it is placed so far back in the car, a recent (2002) mid-field gearbox is known to weigh 43Kg fully dressed.

A sequential manual transmission allows the driver to select either the next gear (e.g. shifting from first gear to second gear) or the previous gear (e.g., shifting from third gear to second gear), operated either via electronic paddle-shifters mounted behind the steering wheel or with a sequential shifter.
