Define the problem. Brainstorm solutions. Choose a solution and act on it. Go over each step with the class. Point out that before the problem solving begins, the people in the conflict have to agree to work it out. In order for problem solving to work, they have to agree to really try to work it out, and to not yell or call names.

Mini lessons can also be used to fill up a small pocket of extra time. Although the specifics of a mini lesson vary, many education experts agree that a mini lesson should last no more than ten to fifteen minutes, and should contain four basic components, called "connection," "teaching," "active engagement," and "link."

Model the problem with a "think aloud" (i.e., "The pigs faced a problem in this story because the big, bad wolf kept blowing down their houses"). Continue the think aloud to model the solution (i.e., "The pigs solved their problem when they went to their brother's brick house, which the wolf couldn't blow down").

A mini lesson is a short lesson with a narrow focus that provides instruction in a skill or concept that is situated into the larger unit of study. A mini lesson typically last between 10-20 minutes and can be used to teach particular skills, extend previous learning, create interest in a topic and generate questions, or introduce strategies.
