Then label the drive with something enticing and drop the drive at an on-site high traffic area. If an employee picks it up, plugs it in their workstation and opens the file, it will "call home" and report the "fail" to your KnowBe4 console.

Look for drives that provide event logging and geotagging, so information on what computer, and where, is retained on every use. 5. Enforce USB scanning on all corporate computers whenever a thumb drive is plugged in. This can help ensure no malware or malicious programs are on the drive.
